AFFIDAVIT OF HENRY M. REDDEN


State of Alabama

Before me, a Notary Public in and for said County and State,
personally appeared Henry M. Redden and, after having been by me first
duly sworn, deposes and says under oath as follows:

1. My name is Henry M. Redden. I am over (19) nineteen years of age
and have personal knowledge of the facts as are set out herein.
2. I am currently the Director of Information Systems for the Alabama
Department of Corrections. I have served in this position since July
of 2007.
3. I have been requested by counsel for the State to run a computer
search to identify the number of illegal aliens currently incarcerated in
the Alabama Prison System.
4. At the present time, it is not possible to identify the total number of
illegal aliens incarcerated in the custody of the Alabama Department
of Corrections. This is because our system does not track inmates by
immigration status.
5. While our records indicate an inmate's place of birth, whether born in
the United States or not, our records do not reflect verification of


which of those inmates born outside of the United States are illegal aliens.

6. I can, however, state that at present there are 182 inmates in the custody of the Department of Corrections who are subject to deportation as a result of having detainers placed upon them by the Department of Homeland Security Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE").
