RE: Central Alabama Fair Housing Center, et al., v. Magee, et al., Civil Action No. 2:11cv982-MHT, U.S. District Court, Middle District of Alabama- Temporary Restraining Order

Effective immediately, pursuant to the instructions of U.S. District Judge Myron Thompson in his November 23, 2011 'Opinion and Order' from the above- styled action, this is written to notify you that you are enjoined from requiring any person who attempts to pay the annual registration fee, required by 1975 Ala. Code, Section 40-12-255, to prove his or her U.S. citizenship or lawful immigration status. You are further enjoined from refusing to issue the manufactured home decal required by 1975 Ala. Code, Section 40-12-255 to any person because that person cannot prove his or her U.S. citizenship or lawful immigration status. A copy of Judge Thompson's temporary restraining order (styled 'Opinion and Order') is enclosed with this memorandum. Read the order and comply with it. The provisions of this order will expire on December 7, 2011, at 4:30 p.m. The provisions of the temporary restraining order only apply to the annual registration fee and decal associated with manufactured homes.
